GENERAL ELECTION, NOVEMBER 5, 2024

The General Election is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. Polls will be open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Cormorant Community Center. As long as you're in line by 8:00 p.m., you'll be given the opportunity to cast your vote, even after the poll closes. You do need to be a Cormorant Township resident to vote at this location.

If you are not a registered voter, it's not too late to vote in this general election. You may register at the Becker County courthouse any time before the election. Items you'll need to provide include:

- Proof of age 18 or older.
- Government issued photo identification.
- Proof of residing in Minnesota for at least 20 days preceding the election, which could be a utility bill, lease agreement, or other document to confirm residency.
